

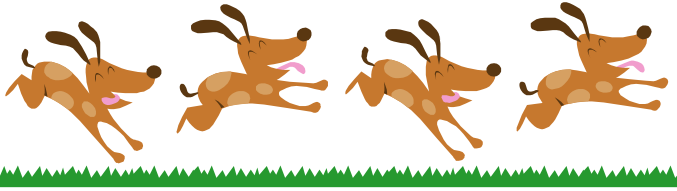

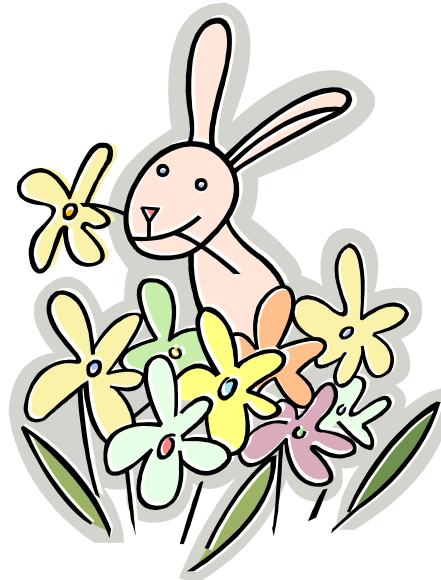

Burning in the City:

A recreational fire is a 3' x 3' x 3' ONLY. Anything over the recreational fire requires a permit, which is free of charge at City Hall.

Absolutely no burning of garbage, building materials or hazardous waste!

Burning barrels and burning of prohibited materials are not allowed.

A fine from the City can cost up to \$700, with a \$300 charge from the Fire Department.

Please keep the following in mind:

Ordinances are established to ensure the enjoyment of each resident's property and to maintain a quality of life for our community. Please be a considerate community member!

- Winter Parking: NO parking on City Streets from 1 Am to 7 AM from Nov. 1st to April 30th—Tag and Tow after 24 hrs.
- Access Channel is located at Charter channel 990 and HBC, Channel 11. Please check for updates and information
- Recreation Vehicles need a permit from Winona County. Do not operate on any City park, playground, recreation area, utility ground or ball fields. And NOT on private property without written consent!
- Doing landscaping? Planting a tree? Call Gopher State One Call FIRST at 1-800-252-1166
- All household garbage must be removed from your property weekly!
- Storage or accumulation of junk in the open is prohibited! This includes junk vehicles that are inoperable, not currently licensed AND no current tabs.
- Building permits can be obtained at City Hall or our website. Needed for additions, outside structures, decks, re-roofing, siding, fences or any water or furnace replacement.
