Railroad letter:	Letter for the weeds still needs to be written by Beth. There is still a pooling issue in that area, though Bill Trygstad did state it probably did not come from the water project. Beth will talk with Chad about getting the bobcat in there and trenching after the fire hydrant to connect to the railroad property.
