<b>DISCUSSION POINTS:</b>	
<b>Blacktop streets:</b>	Discussed the Mobile home park and maybe the need for an engineer designed road for water run off. Also discussed the bridge and the blacktop problems.
<b>Parking lot:</b>	Yaggy-Colby was not in attendance, but did email stating the East Main Street area would not work for the DOT. Discussed placing the parking lot on the City block instead of next to the gas station as it could be used for the playground, pavilion or city hall overflow if needed.
<b>Jerome Daniel:</b>	Jerome Daniel asked about planting trees as a buffer from the neighbors. Zoning Ordinance does state if planting in the front yard the tree line shall not be more than 2 1/2 feet in height. Advised that anything hanging over the neighbors can be cut by them. He asked about building a pergola, the size would be 10'x10', not attached to the home, over a cement sidewalk and not enclosed. Committee recommended asking our Building Inspector what he would recommend. Discussed the fencing options.
<b>Wehlage:</b>	Stated the retention ponds across the road are becoming a noise problems with the frogs. Committee recommends planting evergreens along the East side of Broadway. Also contacting the DNR about controlling the frogs.
<b>Wilbright's fence:</b>	Committee recommended the Council discuss a fine for the fence not facing the right way. They have been warned about the fence needing to be corrected.
<b>RECOMMENDATIONS TO COUNCIL:</b> (ACTION REQUESTED)	
<b>Daniel:</b>	Recommend asking our Building Inspector about pergolas.
<b>Wehlage:</b>	Recommend planting evergreen trees along Broadway to buffer the frog noises.
<b>Wilbright's Fence:</b>	Recommend a fine for not correcting the fence.
