They will travel by bus and stay at a local church. Cost is \$600 per person with about 30 people signed up to go. Their church is a 501(C)3 and would also fall under humanitarian services.

Winstars would like a donation, they have about 5 girls from Stockton on the team, there should be a letter to the SAPG in February asking for the donation.

Since there is no money available to donate, the group will keep these on the list for future donations.

### **Treasurer's Report:**

Checks were made out to the Holiday light contest for a total of \$225 being spent, giving a end total of \$13,527.18.
