Treasurer's Report:

Beth Winchester gave the report, with amount being \$13,625.21. It was requested the money that was set aside as cash for the dance be put back in the bank until a new date is given. This could get the group investigated by the IRS or the gambling control board for having the money for two months. Also, anytime the group needs cash a check should be written out to the bank and not a business we have gambling at.

Unfinished Business:

Summer Teen dance was suppose to be June 19th but was canceled due to lack of kids. Members discussed having the dance after the community ball games in August.

Family night will be Friday, July 24th under the pavilion. However, if it rains it will be canceled.

Community Pick-up baseball game will be Saturday, August 29th at 4:00 P.M. Group will have hot dogs, chips and either water or juice at the game.

Welcome signs tabled, Lisa Gibbs not in attendance.

Members discussed the Stockton Clean up day. A resident had asked the Council to provide dumpsters to have for cleaning up properties. The site would need to be monitored for hazardous waste and would be a one day deal. The Council asked the Promotional Group to look into.
