Main Line:	5 & 6 Street. Not sure if blacktopping will be done this year, depends upon blacktop plant.	
	All main line south of Hwy 14 is finished, some lines already pressurized. Discussion held on	
	the culverts which will need to be re-graded. Requested that Chad put the water way back	
	onto the 8310 W. Main & 8370 W. Main. Complaints being received of them working later	
	than 8:00 pm, Trygstad will discuss that with them. Blacktop that has been broken will need to	
	be patched, and some fire hydrants are to be checked for straightness. Trygstad will create a	
	punch list at the end of things that will need to be done before the project will be paid in full.	
Reservoir:	Reforming walls has to be redone as they were only 20" thick and were suppose to be 22"

	Curb & gutter is staked and hope blacktop street will be put in this year.	
Water Rates:	Parker did a water billing model. \$3.11 per 1,000 gallons, plus a \$10 base fee this averages out	
	to \$24 per month at 4,500 gallons average use. Anything over 9,000 gallons usage would be	
	billed at \$2.33/1,000 gallons. This is all based on the	e 40 users already on the line and another
	40 users to hook up.	
Chad: Generator:	Generator has two estimates for electrical wiring. 1	Dick's Electric says generator can't be
	used for sewer 2) Norm's says it can be protable and used for the sewer.
