MPCA:	Sarah Larson is the City's contact, and she is looking into having the HRA distribute the gu	rant
Ordinance:	Discussion was held on some changes: having one line to the property, but making the	
	property owner responsible for that line and not renters. Use of hydrants by authorized	
	personnel and if buying in bulk rate they must have a permit, accompanied by City	
	employee, have a backflow preventor, and provide a meter or a predetermined tank.	
	Curb stop boxes should only be turned on by City employee, and must have 24-hour	
	advance for inspection. Private wells should be inspected by certified plumber, and repa	irs
	on wells shall be for mechanical repairs only. All areas should state property owner, not	
	resident or consumer.	
Water Project:	Pay Estimate #1 for Haselton at \$265,784.68 with a 5% retainage kept until the project is	
	finished. Every month will have a pay estimate from now on. Pipe under the creek on Highway	
	14 has been pulled, but it seized up on the contractor so a new pipe will need to be drille	ed.
	Still planning on December 1st deadline, with no extensions as of yet. Blacktop to be	
	laid November 15th. They will do all of the South side of town first, with the North being	
	done second. Area along Hwy. 14 to be direction drill instead of trenched between C Str	eet
	and the creek. Also directional drill from E Street west to alleyway area.	
	Pay Estimate #1 for Wapasha is \$248,073.42 with 5% retainage.	
	The reservoir road is graded, some storm drains laid, base is done and some walls are be	
	formed. There was a new soil test done and tests came back okay for the amount of pre	ssure
	the reservoir will put on the area.	
	Complaints coming in about the dust and cleaning up after themselves. It is the contract	ors
	responsibility to fix anything they take our or if it becomes a problem.
