One complaint on pressure. Right now the well is pumping 160 gallons per minute, and the reservoir is about 1/4 of the way filled. Need to do a leakage test, and take measurements like bacteria and chlorine. Will need to move the pressure switch on the wellhouse pump, or could let the grant pay for a new switch. Committee recommends a change order to have Wapasha put in a new switch. Could also get the electrician paid for to hook up the generator. Still need to do landscaping, blacktop the parking area, and put the gate in, with project being

14-foot gates. Mark Potter will take the other one and put it above the reservoir. Make a list of procedural documents like hydrant flushing, chemicals and generator. Whom to call in case of emergency. Possibly have tags with information on the back, would like a copy kept at City Hall. Action Item for Chad:

Water Mains: Residential hook up will be around the middle of May, will know more at City Council meeting May 11th.

Service lines are done but Ziebells, will be extra cost since they damaged their moling machine and need to bring in the ram.

4-H garden area will be sodded except where the outline is for the garden. Native grass areas should not be getting anything Sodding/Seeding: since the areas will be sprayed with round-up, though Heselton would be responsible for erosion control, area should be leveled and stablized before signing off to the green space committee. 13th Street will be seeded. East Ninth street still has water

running across road to Wacholz Drive.

8900 Old Co. Rd. 23: Lilla's fence was taken out as part of the project, it was not in good shape and she would like compensation since she doesn't

want it put back. The plan says to put it back, need to ask her if she wants it put back and if so, where is it, otherwise

finished around June 1st. There is no pricing on the gate, Bill will have a 28-foot gate, this will be a stock gate with two

City will not pay for a new fence if she doesn't have it. will begin this week, though Wehlage has a pile of dirt on his road.

Street Sweeping: North Broadway Bridge: has been approved for construction, sewer line will need to be extended and dug deeper. Need to find the original contract

from Erickson Engineering to see who was going to pay for the extention.

Two left to sign, and Trygstad still needs to write Potter and Wadewitz ones
