DISCUSSION POINTS:		
Water Project update:	Dirt still has rocks and debris in it, piles like this should be removed. Paul Petterson's culvert has high sod, though the culvert isn't shown on the plan. Lots of standing water in ditches, some will be reshaped. Bambenek/Johnson/Barnholtz water problem is on the flood bonding project, but City should be doing mosquito control. There were ten new hookups total and Chad will need to refine his chlorine and flouride in the system.	
Water Leak:	Chad still thinks there is a leak - Bill T. did look at the records and does not see a problem. Though the City is using more that what is being recorded by our residents.	
Reservoir:	Erosion on the reservoir road, some holes will need to be filled in and re-seeded. Some of the areas did not take seed and Wapasha will need to come back to fix it.	
Miscellaeous:	Blacktopping should begin soon since sodding is almost finished. Silt fencing will be removed once ground has been established. Letter to those that don't have the outside water meters up.	
Recommendation:	Writing letter to Dave Kramer & DM&E about Co. Rd. 23 drainage and along railroad tracks. Still standing water there.
