<b>DISCUSSION POINTS:</b>		
<b>Wapasha:</b>	Will meet Friday, May 27th about 9 am - they will bring their seed guy to look at the damaged areas. Covered area is mostly in clover, but is growing good.	
<b>Scenic Ridge Dr.:</b>	Water still running down the road, and not in the ditch - 8480 E. 9th will be contacted since their landscaping drainage runs across 9th Street and doesn't make the corner to deposit into the ditch.	
<b>Haselton:</b>	They have adjusted the curb stop boxes, the majority of them needed to be corrected. They have done most of the punchlist, but there are some areas that will need to be blacktopped. Rollin' Sunset Dr., E & 8th Street, Broadway North, and E. 9th by Wacholz Drive will all need to be looked at. Chad needs to check the valve on Co. Rd. 23 to see if they've fixed that, he will let Bill know whether it's been done or not.	
<b>Fitzgerald:</b>	Most have been fixed, though they need to clean the ball fields of blacktop, and pick up their ladder, fence posts and snow fencing at the Maintenance garage. Tiger Lily Tattoo seems to still be leaking water, must be sealed. Beth will contact them about these things.	
<b>Generator:</b>	Dave Johannes did contact Norman's Electric, they are requesting a load test which will cost \$1200. Committee requested Beth call to get it done. Norm's was at the well house to gather data on what is needed. Cost will be between \$8,000 to \$9,000 for the transformer & outlet on generator also a fuseable disconnect.	
<b>Lift #4:</b>	Has been plugging up with clean wipes this past month, a note will go into sewer billing to remind people what not to send to the sewer.	
<b>Garvin View Estates:</b>	Manholes in the subdivision need to be cut around and new blacktop laid. Council should discuss the cracks and repairs around town that will need to be done like Hickory Lane.	
<b>Bridge:</b>	Two days ahead of schedule, sewer work should begin 3rd week in June	
<b>Sewer Ponds:</b>	\$800 to shot blast one transfer - Chad will get a cost estimate for covers soon.	
<b>Sewer Line:</b>	Main Street between E and Broadway needs to be repaired. It was televised six years ago and there were leaks then. Since council agreed to televise and repair a section of the City each year, this is the section that should get done first.
