No Pledge of Allegiance was said.

No public voice forum – both due to COVID-19 stay-at-home order.

Neil Hjelmeland made a motion to accept the agenda, with a second from Lisa Gibbs. Motion passed.

Travis McElmury made a motion to accept the financial report and to pay all bills. Motion seconded by Neil Hjelmeland; motion passed.

Dave Johannes made a motion to accept the March 17, 2020 minutes, seconded by Lisa Gibbs. Motion passed.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

**E. 9<sup>th</sup> Street Sewer:** Tim Stockman would like approval of the plan to begin the topography work. The appraisal of a property cannot be done until May but it should be around \$15,000. The assessments and project approval are not joined together but parallel, once the project goes to sealed bid then the City will have a construction meeting to discuss assessments. Once decided upon amount and interest percentage, then a public hearing for the assessments can be made. Travis McElmury made a motion to approve the Sanitary Sewer Extension in the amount of \$219,472.50. Motion seconded by Lisa Gibbs; motion passed unanimously.

**Mike Wadewitz:** New home for North Broadway, Greg Olson has signed off on the building plan, and the site plan has been approved. Dave Johannes made a motion to accept the building permit of Mike Wadewitz, seconded by Neil Hjelmeland. Motion passed unanimously.
