The second quote was from 8th Street, along the properties at 81060 E. 9th and 81030 E. 9th and heading west, stopping at the first house on the south side, for a cost of \$171,890. Discussion was held on the price, which other homes would benefit, and when or how to assess these homes. Clerk Winchester will request a new cost quote for just the E. 8th to E. 9th Street leg, and also request a new quote for the whole project for the next council meeting.
