Public Voice Forum: James Blagborne stated they will be moving to Chicago and be gone by the end of the week. They have lived here 10 years and would like to thank the council for all their hard work.

Carissa Blagborne made a motion to accept the agenda; motion seconded by Mark Potter. Motion passed.

Dave Johannes made a motion to approve the financial report and to pay all bills. Lisa Gibbs seconded the motion; motion carried.

Carissa Blagborne made a motion to accept June 10, 2025, minutes; motion seconded by Mark Potter. Motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS

Communication Tower: The company sent the lease agreement; it has been sent to the City Attorney for preview. Discussion will be held at the next council meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Resignation: Carissa Blagborne has a letter resigning her seat for City Council effective July 8, 2025. She will be moving to Chicago on Friday, July 11, 2025. A resolution is needed, and the council will appoint a member to fill her seat.

Community Center window cleaning: Quote from Winona Window Washing is a cost of \$570.84. Carissa Blagborne made a motion to approve the quote; motion seconded by Lisa Gibbs. Motion carried.

Donation Request: Lewiston Sportsman's Club is requesting a donation in support of the MN Firearms Safety Training classes. Each student is given a blaze orange hunting cap and a gun lock to help them have the proper tools for safe hunting. SAPG just donated \$5,000, so \$500 needs to be donated. Mark Potter made a motion to donate \$500 to the Lewiston Sportsman's Club. Motion seconded by Lisa Gibbs; motion passed.

CITY MAINTENANCE

- The water reservoir was inspected; the next inspection will be in 5 years. There were no problems.
- Bids on plows and sanders for the new truck came in. Universal Truck was \$18,000; Michael's Truck Company, with a smaller plow was \$16,500 and Volkart Welding was \$17,700. Mark Potter made a motion to approve the Volkart Welding quote since it's a local company. Lisa Gibbs seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously.

Dave Johannes made a motion to close the Stockton City Council meeting with a second from Carissa Blagborne. Motion passed unanimously; the meeting was adjourned at 6:20 PM.
