

On Tuesday, March 26, 2013, Mayor Christopher Parker, called to order the Stockton City Council meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. Council members in attendance were Neil Hjelmeland, Jack Roberts, Lisa Gibbs and Chad Wangen.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Under the Public Forum, Chad Larson would like to discuss the new City truck, under City Maintenance.

Lisa Gibbs made a motion to accept the March 12, 2013 minutes, with a second by Jack Roberts. Motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS:

Grant Application – Must have a resolution passed by the Council to request \$150,000 in funds for the Multi-Use Trail System. Neil Hjelmeland made a motion to accept the resolution, with a second by Chad Wangen. Motion passed unanimously.

Acquiring 2 lots in Garvin View Estates: Discussion was held on paying \$35,000 for one lot, with Harmida, Inc. donating the second lot. City would pay \$20,000 up front with three payments of \$5,000 annually on July 31st. Lots 4 & 5, Block one of the Garvin View Estates Second Addition. The strategic plan of two years ago, laid out the park and playground area in GVE. Jack Roberts made a motion to purchase Lots 4 & 5, Block 1 of Garvin View Estates, Second addition at \$20,000 upfront and \$5,000 annually on July 31st. Motion seconded by Neil Hjelmeland. Motion passed unanimously.

BUILDING PERMIT:

Sean Logan garage: Clerk had received the site plan, materials list, truss specs and application. The old garage will come down, the concrete slab will be removed and a new slab with driveway will be poured. City Building Inspector, Greg Olson has looked over the plan and has no problems. Jack Roberts made a motion to accept Sean Logan's building permit application with a second by Lisa Gibbs. Motion passed.

CITY MAINTENANCE:

City Truck: Lewiston Auto faxed a quote for a 2013 Chevrolet Silverado for \$36,485. Minus discounts and trade in of the old truck, plus tax, title and licensing, motor vehicle tax, and registration fees the total would come to \$20,785.75. This does not include the plow, but does have the plow package. Jack Roberts made a motion to purchase the 2013 Chevrolet Silverado, with a second from Neil Hjelmeland. Motion passed unopposed.

Jack Roberts made a motion to close the City Council meeting, motion seconded by Lisa Gibbs. Motion passed, meeting adjourned at 7:17 P.M.
