- **Liability waiver:** Mark Potter made a motion to not waive the statutory tort limits for liability coverage. Travis McElmury seconded the motion; motion passed unanimously.

CITY MAINTENANCE

- Discussed televising and cleaning more sewer lines, Chad wants to wait to make sure the current fix of PPIP is holding and fixed.
- Discussed putting a steel roof on the warming garage, Chad will do the job himself.
