On Tuesday, September 24, 2013, Mayor Chris Parker called to order the Stockton City Council meeting at Stockton City Hall at 7:00 P.M. Councilmembers in attendance were Neil Hjelmeland, Lisa Gibbs, Jack Roberts, and Chad Wangen.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Public Voice Forum: Jack Roberts stated the outside lights at the Community Center are not on at night, but Chad Larson just fixed that this morning.

Chad Wangen made a motion to accept the 9-10-2013 minutes, seconded by Neil Hjelmeland. Motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

Haselton: The blacktop repairs are finished, but the culvert at D & Sixth is not. Leasah Lilla stated the lip that is now part of her driveway, and if Bill Trygstad could fix that, also a corner is missing some blacktop which will create an erosion problem.

Crackfilling: Bargen Inc., is finished with the job, the total cost is \$14,247.00, with 10,280-feet of cracks being done. Both Chad Larson and Bill Trygstad are happy with the work done.

Blacktop Hickory/Jenny Lane: Dunn Blacktop was the only company that bid, with a total amount of \$197,000.29. Dave McCorquodale would be paying for about \$15,350.48 for the water and sewer trenches that were done as part of the water project Phase III. Bill Trygstad summed up the bid from Dunn.

Division 1: Milling, patching trench areas and bringing up to level, mill driveways & street intersections 4', rebuild the bus cul-de-sac and lay a 2" overlay at a cost of \$141781.00 – Dunn would do all the patching and repairing, rebuild the cul-de-sac this Fall with the overlay next Spring.

Division 2: Bus cul-de-sac to end of Hickory lane with curb n gutter at a cost of \$17,435.96 Division 3: All of Jenny Lane redone - \$31,623.33

Division 4 is the 3 manhole patches at Garvin View Estates with a cost of \$6,160. Chad Larson did get an estimate from Asphalt Armor in Winona for the GVE manholes at a cost of \$2052. Only difference is Dunn Blacktop is a 4-inch blacktop layer with Asphalt is a 3-inch layer.

Dunn Blacktop would do the milling and patching areas this Fall with an overlay next Spring. Dave McCorquodale has five repair areas from the water project at a cost of about \$15,350.48, which will need to be made into an agreement from Wayne Schauble.

Mayor Chris Parker made a motion to do Division one from Dunn Blacktop only, motion seconded by Jack Roberts. Motion passed completely.

Speed Signs: Jack Roberts requested speed signs for the ATV/snowmobile speeding problem. They are running down the street a lot faster than the 10 MPH than the ordinance states. Clerk Winchester will check costs of ATV/Snowmobile MPH signs, and to bring estimates to next council meeting.

CITY MAINTENANCE

- Ballfields wait on Spring now
- Culvert Repair: A Street at a cost \$1320 and West 8th is \$1008, the blacktop is sinking over the culverts, Asphalt Armor quoted the pricing.
- Manhole repair is also Asphalt Armor at a price of \$2052. Jack Roberts made a motion to accept the bid from Asphalt Armor for Culverts and manhole covers. Motion second by Lisa Gibbs, motion passed unanimously.

Chad Wangen made a motion to close the Stockton City Council meeting, with a second from Lisa Gibbs. Motion passed collectively, meeting adjourned at 7:37 P.M.
