ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE #110-A:

"ORDINANCE # 110-A, AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SEWER USE REGULATIONS

An Ordinance regulating the use of public sewers and drains, private wastewater disposal, the installation and connection of building sewers, and the discharge of waters and wastes into the public sewer system; and providing penalties for violations thereof."

THE CITY COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS, that Ordinance #110-A be amended as follows:

At "<u>ARTICLE I. DEFINITIONS</u>.", add # "22) "Multifamily Dwelling"- a building which provides two or more separate residential units, each with separate living quarters, within the same structure."

At "ARTICLE IX. USER RATE SERVICE CHARGES." amend to read as follows:_

"Section 2. An account for services shall be kept for each user. For all multifamily dwellings, each residential unit shall be considered as an individual user. Unless each unit is metered separately, the building shall be invoiced at the residential rate, times the number of residential units it contains."

And also amend: **Section 2.** Bills will be mailed to users the property owners.
