ORDINANCE 2016-OCTOBER-11

CITY OF STOCKTON AN ORDINANCE OPTING OUT OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2016, Governor Dayton signed into law the creation and regulation of temporary family health care dwellings, codified at Minn. Statutes 462.3593, which permits and regulate temporary family health care dwellings;

WHEREAS, subdivision 9 of Minn. Statutes 462.3593 allows cities to "opt out" of those regulations;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOCKTON, ORDAINS TO OPT-OUT OF MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593;

Pursuant to authority granted by Minnesota Statutes, Section 462.3593, subdivision 9, the City of Stockton opts-out of the requirements of Minn. Statute 462.3593, which defines and regulates Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings.

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication.
